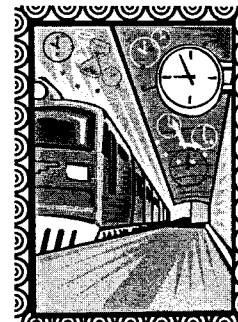

We will explore Union Station with a docent tour.

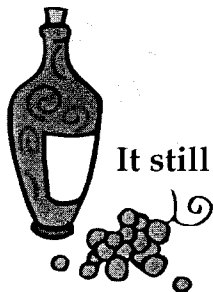


The San Antonio Winery was established in 1917.
